



## **Terms of the Competition for the Best Report Presented at the Session Young Scientists of the 2<sup>nd</sup> International Conference 'Human Ecology', Szczecin 9-10.06.2016**

### **1. The Target Group**

The competition is open to young scientists, ie. doctoral students and students taking an active part in the deliberations of the 2nd International Conference 'Human ecology' in Szczecin, hereinafter referred to this Conference.

### **2. The objectives of the competition**

- dissemination of research results in line with the interest of young scientists, as members of research teams, in the field of interdisciplinary aspects of human ecology;
- inspiring the scientific and academic discussions;
- developing the ability to comply with the rigor of discipline of scientific forums.

### **3. The place and time of the competition**

The competition will be held at the venue of the Conference, namely in the building of Faculty of Environmental Management and Agriculture of West Pomeranian University of Technology in Szczecin, 17 Juliusz Słowacki Street.

### **4. The subjects of the competition**

The object of the contest are reports presented at the Scientific Session of Young Scientists of the Conference given by doctoral student or student who is the **sole author** or **the first co-author**.

### **5. Settlement of the contest the contest and awards**

Reports and posters will be evaluated by the Competition Commission appointed by the Organizing Committee on a point scale, in a secret voting. The authors of the oral reports with the highest number of points will be awarded. Results of the contest will be announced during the Conference. The winners will receive diplomas and prizes.

### **6. Formal requirements**

Oral report presented at the session of Young Scientists of the Conference should be prepared in Microsoft Power Point or Open Office Impress, and the duration should not exceed 15 minutes.

### **7. Final Provisions**

The decision of the jury is none, which means that there is no appeal from it. The organizers reserve the right to develop and publish the results of the competition. Joining the contest involves the consent to the processing of personal data necessary for this purpose.
